deadline for figuring out what you're actually building before

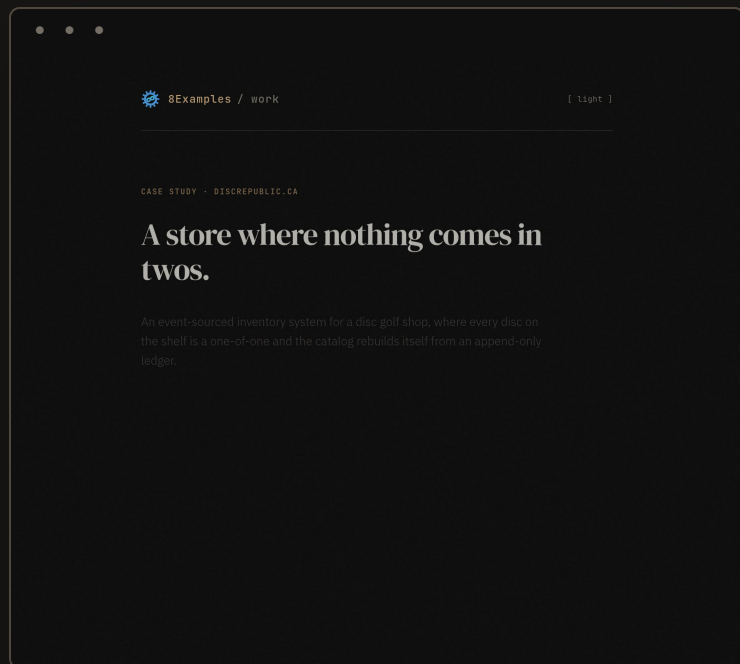
You can't shortcut understanding.

Understand it before you build it.

The expression is the discovery. We walk through the real behaviour, step by step, until everyone can point at the same thing.

That work can be a one-page website, an autonomous migration loop, or an AI worker answering a customer. The scale changes. The habit does not.



01 Is it worth it?

Run the cheapest credible test before committing to the full build.

02 What is it?

Define the product through examples: given this, when that, then this happens.

03 What happens?

Lay out commands, events, and views over time so the whole system is visible.

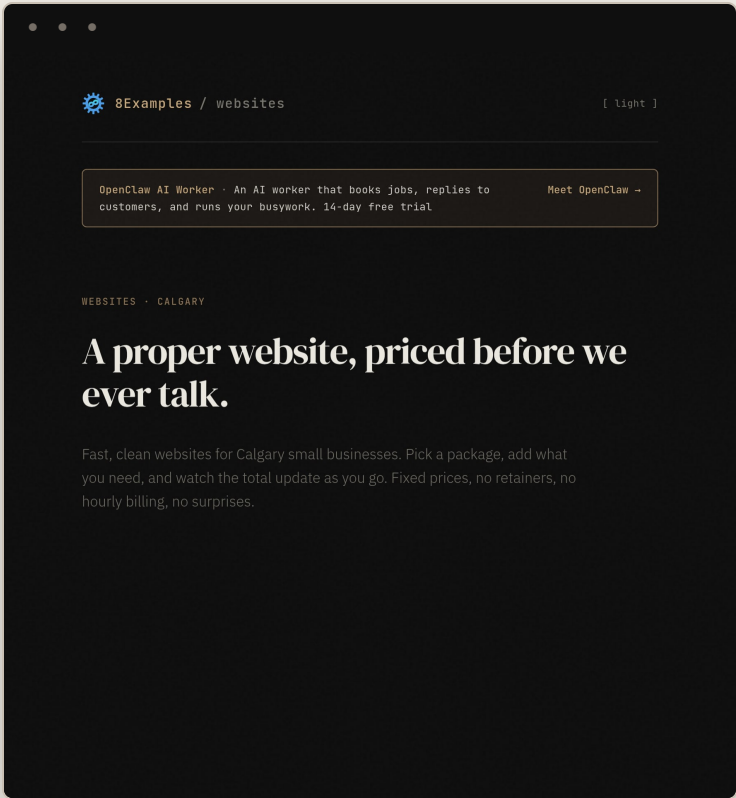
04 Can we prove it?

Build the tests and feedback loops that make the claim measurable.

05 Can it stay simple?

Prefer small, inspectable systems that are cheap to run and easy to change.

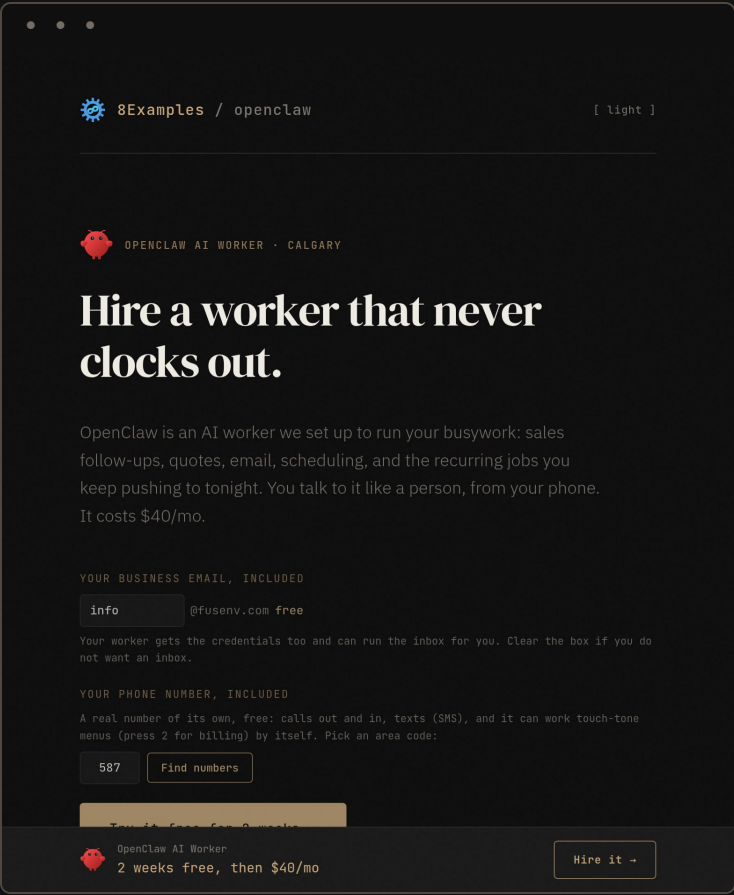

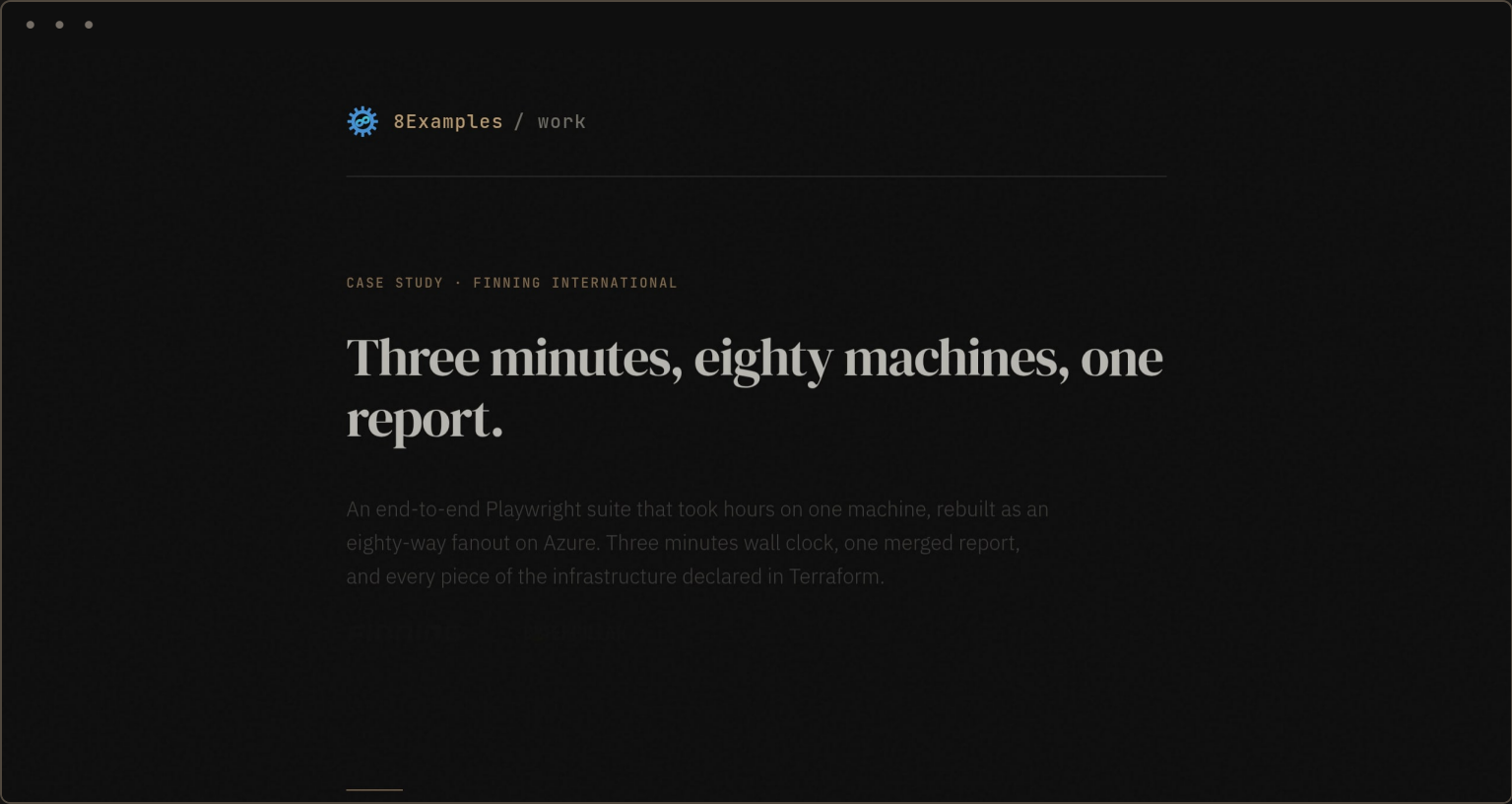

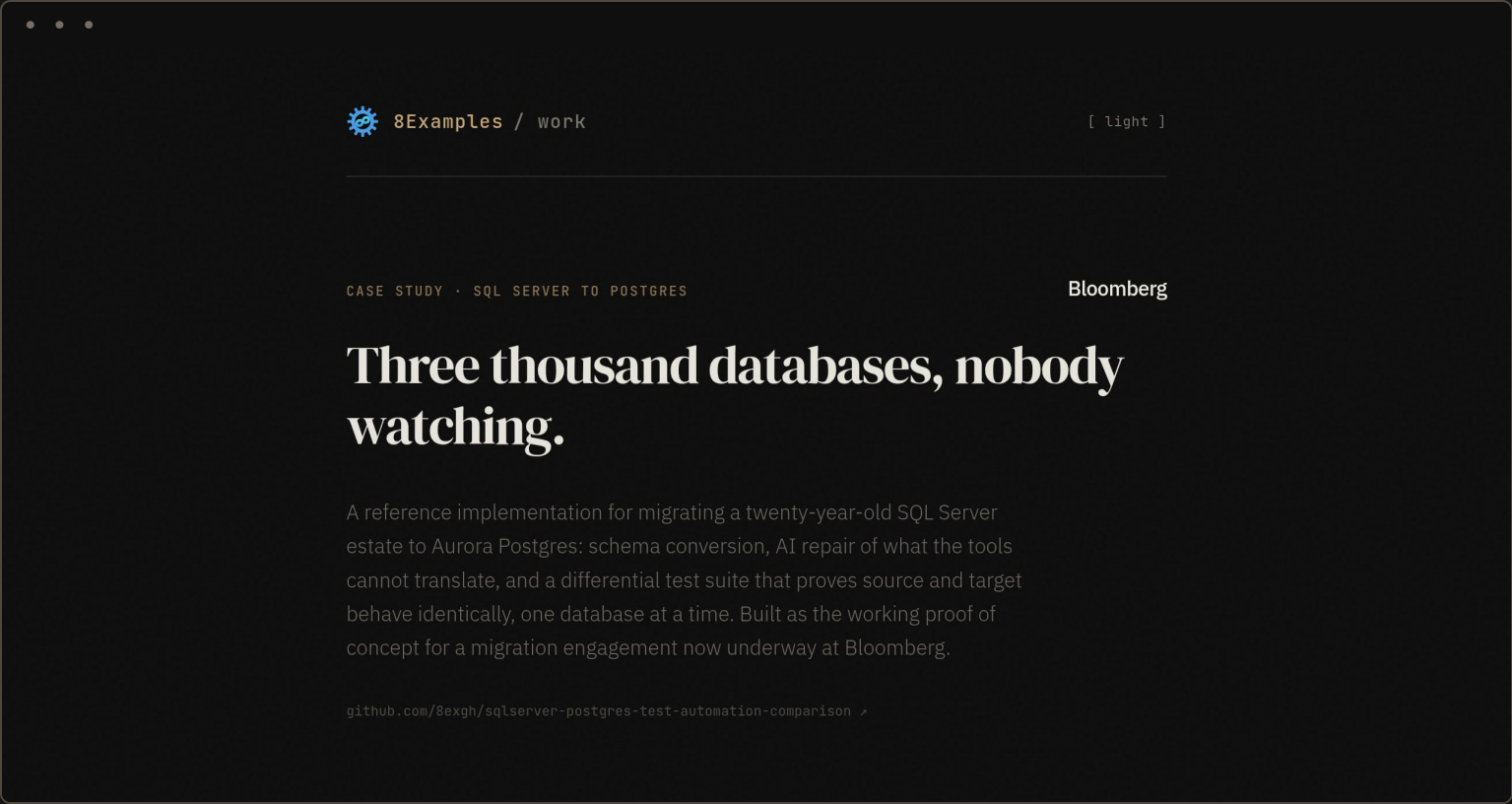
The problem. An end-to-end Playwright suite took hours on one machine, so it ran at night and teams rationed coverage.

The move. We walked the timeline of eighty replicas starting together, then built a sharded fanout on Azure Container App Jobs. A small function distributes shard numbers through a blob lease, while every replica reports its result.

The result. The suite completes in about three minutes. Coverage grew because fast tests stopped being a scarce resource. The whole environment lives in Terraform, with no pet servers to maintain.

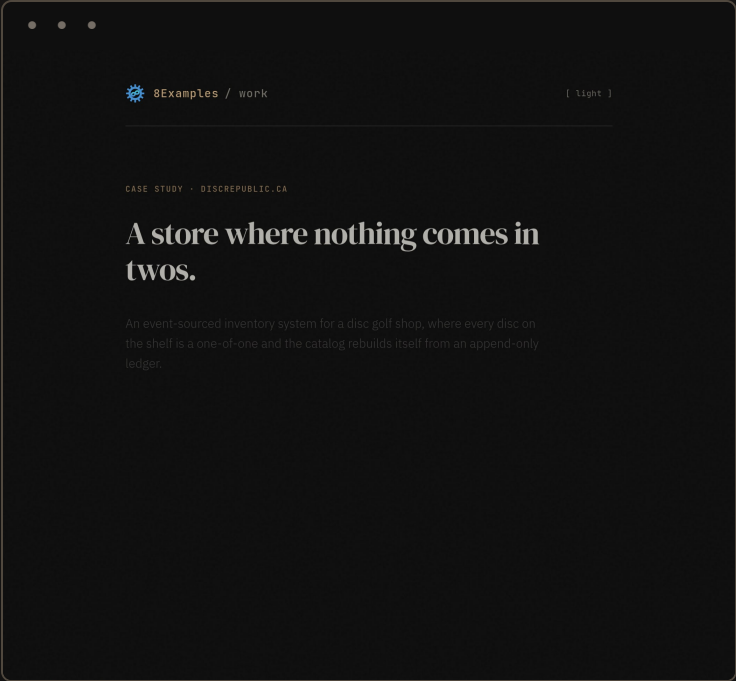
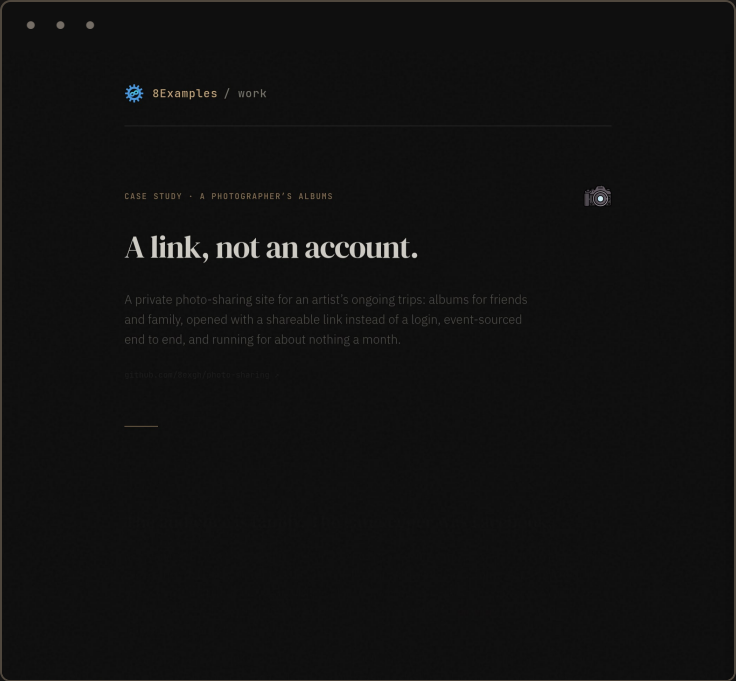
The problem. Tables are the easy part. Behaviour buried in stored procedures and triggers is where a migration can quietly change the business.

The move. Convert the schema, let AI repair what conventional tools cannot translate, then run the same inputs against source and target. Compare outputs and side effects, repair, and repeat.

The result. An autonomous loop earns the right to continue only when a differential test suite proves equivalence. The proof of concept is now behind a migration engagement underway at Bloomberg.

Small systems. Concrete rules. Real outcomes.



A store where nothing comes in twos.

DiscRepublic's one-of-one inventory is driven by an append-only ledger and two patient background jobs. Shopify assembles itself from the facts.

A link, not an account.

Private family photo albums with one admin password, shareable guest links, and a single SQLite ledger on one small server.

Ink arrives as a webhook.

DocuSign callbacks become facts in a property-management ledger. Retries, duplicates, and out-of-order messages become non-events.

Share the file, skip the account.

One admin uploads. Everyone else clicks an unguessable link. Files expire automatically and the whole path is tested on every push.
